

#### Our Rabbi writes....

A cursory glance at our calendar tells us that fall has arrived, hopefully confirmed by a drop in temperature. However, the Jewish calendar, informing us that the month of Elul, the month of preparation leading up to the High Holidays, has a more powerful message for us.

The Hebrew letters that spell Elul, also spell out an acrostic which translates into "I am my Beloved's and my Beloved is Mine". Elul contains the message of the urgency to draw close to G-d, our Beloved Creator.

Rabbi Moshe Chaim Luzzatto, the Ramchal, a great philosopher, encapsulates in one paragraph the whole point of our existence, and in doing so gives us an answer. In his book, The Way of God (1:4:6) he writes, "The root purpose of the service of God is for the human being to constantly turn to his Creator, to realize that he was created for the sole purpose of being drawn close to his Creator...." Everything that happens to us in this world is for one reason and one reason alone: to get closer to the Almighty, to feel that I am for my Beloved and my Beloved is for me. The Jew understands that everything God does is for our good; it is an expression of His love. Every judgment He renders – whether a windfall or a bankruptcy – is exactly what we need to grow closer to Him. The key is recognizing G-d's presence in our lives.

If you truly want to prepare for Rosh Hashanah, use this month to search every corner of your life and appreciate that G-d is present in so many different ways. If we can see the hand of G-d in the events of our life, we are ready for the Days of Awe that fast approach.

If you're missing Rabbi Pearl's weekly Friday night sermon, you're missing (1) his opening joke; (2) his discussion of how the week's Torah reading is relevant to our lives today; (3) his inspirational blessing; and (4) our lively discussions & delicious treats at the Oneg. Services are one hour; congregation participation is welcome & rewarding.


Family News:
