#### Our Rabbi writes....

After the endless parade of holidays, it is almost with a sense of relief that we begin a month devoid of celebration. The month of Cheshvan is referred to by the Talmud and works of Jewish law as 'Mar Cheshvan" the bitter month of Cheshvan. The bitterness this month is labeled with is due to the absence of holidays or special celebrations. Chanukah is down the road, but for now, our calendar is quiet.

While there are no holidays this month, there are other dates of historical importance. The one most significant to me is November 9th, the anniversary of the infamous pogrom that swept across Germany in 1938, destroying most synagogues and consigning 30,000 Jews to concentration camps. It was the beginning of the Holocaust, and a tragic end to the one-thousand-year history of German Jewry.

Some years back on a trip to Germany, I visited a classmate from YU who had become the chief rabbi of Munich. We toured the city, which was very interesting. It was the center of the Nazi party and is filled with landmarks marking the rise and reign of their evil crusade. My friend pointed out to me the town hall, where, on November 9th, 1938, Joseph Goebbels, the Nazi propaganda chief, summoned his storm troopers to attack and terrorize German Jews.

"And two years ago," my friend proudly told me "I hosted a national conference of German rabbis, meeting in the same room that Goebbels used."

What a strange turn of history, that the same walls that hosted hatred and evil became a place of renewal for the Jewish people. "Mar Cheshvan" the bitter, empty month, can be a time of renewal and rebirth. Jewish life is an endless tale of renewal and revival. Let this month be the same for us.

If you're missing Rabbi Pearl's weekly Friday night sermon, you're missing (1) his opening joke; (2) his discussion of how the week's Torah reading is relevant to our lives today; (3) his inspirational blessing; and (4) our lively discussions & delicious treats at the Oneg. Services are one hour; congregation participation is welcome & rewarding.


